

NECC to Offer New Course at RTEC in April 2009

If you would like to acquire skills that can prepare you for an exciting career, you'll want to check out this program being offered at RTEC this spring.

When you complete this 16-credit program, you'll have a starting base that will let you branch off into a career in one of these technical fields:

- **Irrigation**
- **Ethanol**
- **Wind Energy**
- **Electrician**
- **HVAC**
- **Electro-Mechanical**

This course will be offered through a special partnership with Northeast Community college (NECC) in Norfolk, NE. Upon successful completion of the program, you can enter the workforce armed with an introduction to electrical basics, motor control systems and automation control fundamentals or you can continue your studies and apply these credit hours toward a degree at NECC.

The course will run on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from Apr. 7, 2009 through Aug. 26, 2009. Classes will be held from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. with a one-hour break for lunch.

Cost of the course, which includes fees, textbooks and tools, is \$2,484.25 for Nebraska residents and \$2,740.25 for non-Nebraska residents.

Financial assistance is available for those who qualify for the South Dakota Department of Labor's Workforce Investment Act program.
