

# **CNC Class to Begin at RTEC Jan. 12, 2010**

YANKTON - If you are hoping to launch a career in the machine tooling field, you won't want to miss the Computer Numeric Control (CNC) Operator Basics course that will be offered at RTEC beginning Jan. 12, 2010.

The Business and Industry Training course, being presented by Northeast Community College from Norfolk, NE, will prepare you to enter the workforce as a trained machine tool operator. It could also help you lay the foundation for an associate of applied science degree.

During the program, you will complete three sections:

- Intro to Machine Operations
- Conventional Machining
- CNC Machining

You will also cover additional topics including machine math, metallurgy, measurement, blue prints and tolerancing.

Classes begin Jan. 12, 2010 and run through June 15, 2010. For your convenience, the program features evening class times on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:30 p.m. to 9 p.m. at RTEC, 1200 W. 21<sup>st</sup> St. in Yankton.

Upon successful completion of this course, you will receive a Business and Industry Training Certificate from Northeast Community College.

Cost of this Business and Industry Training program is \$2,300. Books, fees and scientific calculators are included.
